# Collective Possession To Advance - Back Four/Midfield Shape

Collective Possession To Advance: Back Four/Midfield Shape. Full backs width, center backs depth, holding midfielders in gaps.

- Angle between two center backs.
- Full back high and wide.
- Back four in a good bowl/umbrella shape in possession.
- Holding midfielders offer supporting positions with good angles to play through.



### Collective Possession To Advance: Lack of depth from center backs, width from opposite full back.

Collective Possession To Advance: Lack of depth from center backs, width from opposite full back.

Lack of depth from center backs creates less space in midfield for players to find to receive the ball, also means the ball is forced forward instead of beginning a controlled attacking build up.



### Collective Possession To Advance, into Imbalance To Penetrate

Collective Possession To Advance, into Imbalance To Penetrate:

- Good, quick combination play.
- Switch point of attack.
- Good rhythm of play
- Quick ball movement
- Good use of the field
- Good movement off the ball, options to play



### **Collective Possession To Advance into Imbalance To Penetrate**

Collective Possession To Advance into Imbalance To Penetrate: Fullback joining in attack, quick combination play, switch point of attack.

- Patience with rhythm in ball movement
- Good rotation of roles

Collective Possession To Advance into Finishing From Final Pass:


- Patience in possession

Imbalance To Penetrate into Finishing from The Final Pass:

- Movement from forward to leave space
- Attacking midfielder draws center back out, central combination play around center back into space created
- Lack of finishing mentality, confidence, risk taking.
